That file is part of the Wraith Scheme build itself, so if you plan on doing serious development with the program, you might wish to make a recursive copy of the entire directory,

in a separate location where you can use it without messing up the build structure. (The directory contains images which are used by the HTML file, and also contains several other useful HTML files.)
