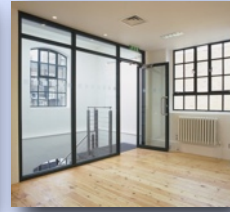


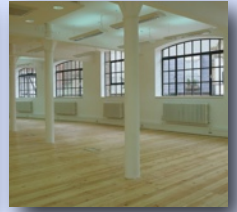
Pump House

This refurbishment of a 1900's pump house located in the Marylebone Conservation Area, just off of the Marylebone High Street introduces a light-weight galvanised staircase and fully glazed screens.

The fire proof stair enclosure allows light to flood through the internal staircase onto the 1,000 sq.m of air conditioned space.
