Apostolic Foundations TH 101 (1.5 credits)

Term 1, Monday 7-8pm (8 weeks)

In this subject we will seek to uncover the apostolic roots of our faith. Our purpose is to lay the deep and solid foundation of Christ in each student. We will examine the core and central teachings of the apostles and how they apply to our lives today. These classes will build a strong foundation in each student so that they can fulfil their destiny in Christ. A few years ago the teachings of this class prepared the way for a powerful outpouring of God's Spirit.

Enjoying God's Word BI 101 (3 credits)

Term 1&2, Monday 8:30-9:30pm (16 weeks)

In this subject we will explore the nature of the Word of God and how to study and interpret it correctly. It is a basic study on Biblical hermeneutics (the science of biblical interpretation) and exegesis (bringing out the meaning of a passage). Such things as the pitfalls of interpretation and understanding difficult passages will be covered. After taking this subject you will be inflamed with a passion for God's Word, and you will make every effort to be "a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth" (2 Tim. 1:15).

Enjoying God PM 201 (1.5 credits)

Term 1, Thursday, 7-8pm (8 weeks)

Enjoying God is foundational to life and ministry. The Westminster Shorter Catechism states: "Man's chief end is to glorify God and to enjoy him forever." In this subject we will explore what it means to enjoy God and how to walk intimately with him. We will see that God is not a hard task-master but a loving Father who longs for us more than we long for him. Students will be set free from religious striving and be empowered to rest in the Lord's embrace.

❑ **The Torah 101-103 (3.0 credits)**

Term 1&2, Thursday, 8:15-9:30pm (16 weeks)

This is an in-depth study of the foundational books of the Bible, covering Genesis to Deuteronomy. In this class we will discover the rich treasures of God's Word and see the Gospel in the Old Testament. This subject is the climax of the week and is always dynamic. You will see and understand God's Word more clearer than ever.

❑ **Kingdom Time & Finance Management MN 101 (1.5 credits)**

Term 2, Monday 7-8pm (8 weeks)

This subject will cover the basics of time management, as well as personal and ministry finance. You will learn skills to manage your time and resources in a God honouring and effective way. Every time we have run this module the students have shared how essential and life-changing the teaching has been.

❑ **The Ministry of Worship & Prayer PM 101 (1.5 credits)**

Term 2, Thursday, 8:30– 9:30pm (8 weeks)

This subject will equip you to minister *first* to the Lord before you minister to people. You will learn the importance and power of worship and prayer. You will also explore the vast subject of prayer, intercession and fasting throughout the Word. By learning spiritual principles from the Bible you will become effective in your worship and prayer life. This subject will inspire you to worship and pray like never before. You will want to "devote [yourself] to prayer" (Col. 4:2).
