Model Prayer Continued

- **YOUR KINGDOM COME. YOUR WILL BE DONE.**
- **GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD**

Things we will cover this lesson:

1. Recognize God is in control of everything!
2. Realize our daily bread will be supplied to us by God no matter what the circumstances!

Assignment:

1. Continue ALONE prayer log.
2. Also go over the material you learned this session. Look up all the scriptures. Put this lesson to practice in your daily life.

**YOUR KINGDOM COME. YOUR WILL BE DONE
ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN**

As a part of our praise and worship, an important declaration for a disciple is that God is in control of **everything!** This part of the model prayer **is** our declaration that God is truly in control and that we desire to cooperate with this fact in all aspects of our life. This is our prayer declaring we believe He is in control *no matter how the circumstances of life may appear to us*. We are desiring His kingdom and His will to come into our situation so He can work His good in it and in us.

I. Your Kingdom Come:

Praise God that:

1. The Kingdom is NOW! - Matt. 4:17,23; Acts 1:3
2. Jesus has completely defeated Satan - Acts 26:18; Gal. 1:4; Col. 1:13; Heb. 2:14.

Man Is:	What Satan Has Done:	What Jesus Came To Do:
Spirit	Death	Life
Soul	Bondage	Freedom
Body	Sickness	Health/Healing

Jesus demonstrated His defeating of satan in all three areas! Thus, a new kingdom!

Realize: Kingdom means a King -- That king is Jesus - Rev. 19:11-16

II. Your Will Be Done:

1. Destiny - Psalm 139:16; Psalm 40:6-8
2. Daily - so you can walk out and fulfill your destiny. Your daily walk is always to be toward your destiny walk.

Note: God's will is to be done on earth to the degree it is done in heaven! Complete and perfect.

Establish and declare His Kingdom and Will to be done in the following:

1. Myself - To do His will today. Declare Jesus as seated on the throne of my life. His will to be done in me as a:
 - (your occupation)
 - child of God
 - minister of the Gospel
 - family person (father or mother, husband or wife, or child)
 - man or woman, youth, etc.
2. My spouse - To do His will today. His will to be done in him/her as a:
 - (their occupation)
 - child of God
 - minister of the Gospel,
 - family person (father or mother, husband or wife, or child)
 - man or woman, youth, etc.
3. My children - To do His will today. And their life mate. And their children. For their life work. To be mighty in Spirit.
4. My church - Pastor, Elders, Vision, The Harvest, Workers, Love, Unity, Praying, Cells, Finances, Growth, Missions, Helping the needy, Faithfulness, Praise and Worship. To be an army! To be a family. To be a rescue ship.
5. Community - local, state, nation, countries, world.

GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD

John 6:33, 35, 48.

In this part of the model prayer, we are showing forth that not only is God in control no matter how the circumstances of life may appear, He is also nurturing us daily during those circumstances. This prayer declares that God is our supplier both of physical needs and spiritual needs everyday of our life. It is like saying to God, *“In whatever happens today, You will give what is good for me. In whatever happens today, my daily bread is in it. I receive it. God only does good! You supply our needs everyday in every circumstance. You will supply what I need today so I can accomplish your will in my life.”*

God will supply what I need everyday so I can accomplish His will in my life!
God does supply everyday what I need so I can accomplish my destiny.

Physical:

1. If we expect God to give to us, then we must be givers (Luke 6:38).
 2. Know it is God’s will to prosper you. Prov. 15:6; 22:4; Psalm 112:1-3
 3. Recognize God as the supplier of daily bread. Phil 4:19; Matt. 6:33.
- Pray for financial blessings for yourself, others, your church.

Spiritual:

Understand the meaning of “Children’s Bread” - Matt 15:21-28; Gal. 3:7,9,29. (In Matt. 15 the “Children's Bread” was healing and deliverance. Jesus said it was for the children of Israel. Gal. 3 teaches all believers are sons of Abraham. Therefore, the “Children’s Bread” is for us.)

“Children’s Bread” is the following and more:

Healing, Deliverance, Kingdom Living, Anointing, Spiritual Gifts, Believer’s Authority, Hearing God's Voice, Knowing God’s Will, Knowing Christ, Love, Hope, Peace, Joy, Faith, Wisdom.

See Ephesians 2:11-22

Ask for “Children’s Bread” for others - Luke 11:5-10.

Daily communion with the Holy Spirit is the key way to discover your daily bread in the circumstances of life.

SUMMATION STATEMENT: Learn to desire God’s will to come into every situation. His will being done is always best. In every circumstance of life, our Father will provide us daily nourishment if we will only realize it and receive it.
