- **Baby / Toddler needs:** diapers (all sizes), baby wipes, formula, clothing / shoes, cribs, and usable car seats.
- **Household goods / small appliances in working condition:** TVs, VCRs, radios, coffee pots, microwaves, computers, clocks, toasters, lamps, sheets, pillows and comforters, kitchenware, etc. **Please call ahead of time in regards to large furniture.**
- **Food and Miscellaneous:** ONLY unopened, non-perishable food accepted – Please check the expiration date! Food, phone, gas, and other gift-cards also accepted.
- **Personal care items:** feminine hygiene products, toilet paper, shampoo and conditioner, and other hair care items, African American hair products, hair dye, fingernail polish and remover, perfume, make-up, toothpaste/floss, and first aid kits.
- **Unopened over-the-counter medication:** vitamins, cold medication, cough drops, Band-Aids, disposable thermometers, rubbing alcohol, peroxide, aspirin, Tylenol, Ibuprofen.
- **Youth programming needs:** art and craft supplies (construction paper, coloring books, crayons, Play-Doh, markers, glue sticks, etc.), tickets to kids events and family activities, sponsors for program activities (field trips, etc.) complete board games, toys (non-battery operated preferred), stuffed animals and children's puzzles.
- **Volunteer opportunities:** children's program chaperones and homework/helpers, special project volunteers, office assistance (data entry, answering phones, bulk mailings), Board Committee volunteers: Fundraising, Nominating, Membership, Women of Achievement, Human Resources, Finance, and some internships available.
