Niccolum = sour
Nitric acid = foetid
Nux vomica = offensive

Oleander = putrid
Opium = delusions of smells

Petroleum = camphor
Phosphorus = cadaverous + violets
Plumbum = spoiled eggs
Pulsatilla = musk
Psorinum = musty
Pyrogen = putrid

Rheum = offensive
Rhododendron = spicy
Rhus tox = musty

Sabadilla = sensitive to the smell of mice
Sanicula = old rain water + old cheese
Secale = wine
Sepia = elder blossom + lilac
Silicea = mercury
Sol-t-ae = spoiled fish
Stannum = musty
Staph = spoiled eggs
Stramonium = semen
Sulphur = eggs + putrid
Syphilinum = spoiled fish

Tellurium = foetid + garlic
Thuja = honey
Tuberculinum = mice

Uran = sweetish
Urtica urens = urine

Vario = pickled herring
Veratrum alb = bitter
Veratrum vir = ether
Viburnum = cat's urine
Viol t = ammonia

Zincum = offensive

So, the menu would read:-

Appetiser of Variolinum (pickled herring), followed by an Artemesia and Aurum
Pizza (cheese and onion), a main course of Benzoic acid, Calc carb, Calc phos and
Chocolate (aromatic sweet and sour fish), dessert would be Thuja (honey), and
all washed down with Sanicula (old rain water)!
