<i>BASIC UNIFORMS</i>	CONFEDERATE GRAY	CONFEDERATE BUTTERNUT
Shirt - Long Sleeve with collar	Solid gray	Solid khaki or tan
Pants	Gray. Variations of brown are also acceptable	Usually a tan color. Variations of khaki are also acceptable. Dress code pants are acceptable.
Socks	To be authentic, wear long wool socks, gray or brown in color	
Shoes	Any pair of black-dark boots or shoes	
Hat	Confederate Kepi	Confederate Kepi or slouch hat.

In addition you will need a canteen or plastic water bottle wrapped in brown paper and a haversack - a bag, preferably made of a natural fiber, to carry snacks and supplies.

All uniforms must follow these regulations with regard to unacceptable items . . .

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POSSIBLE ADDITIONS TO BASIC UNIFORMS - earns higher grade

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Black or brown belt - tinware, pouches, etc. attached - Solid color wool blanket - carried slung over a shoulder by rope - Tin cup - Union or Confederate Jacket | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Uniform adornments such as stripes, medals, buckles, insignia, braids, etc. - Vest - Binoculars - Suspenders |
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
