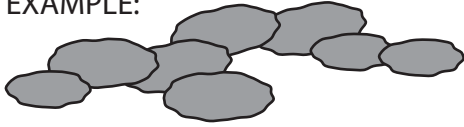

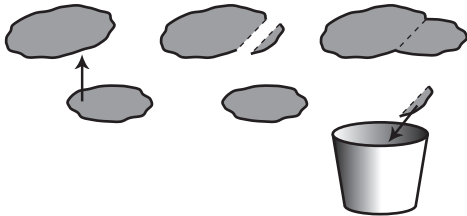

You can print and cut out multiple copies of this page and glue overlapping templates to make an irregular shaped forest to your need.

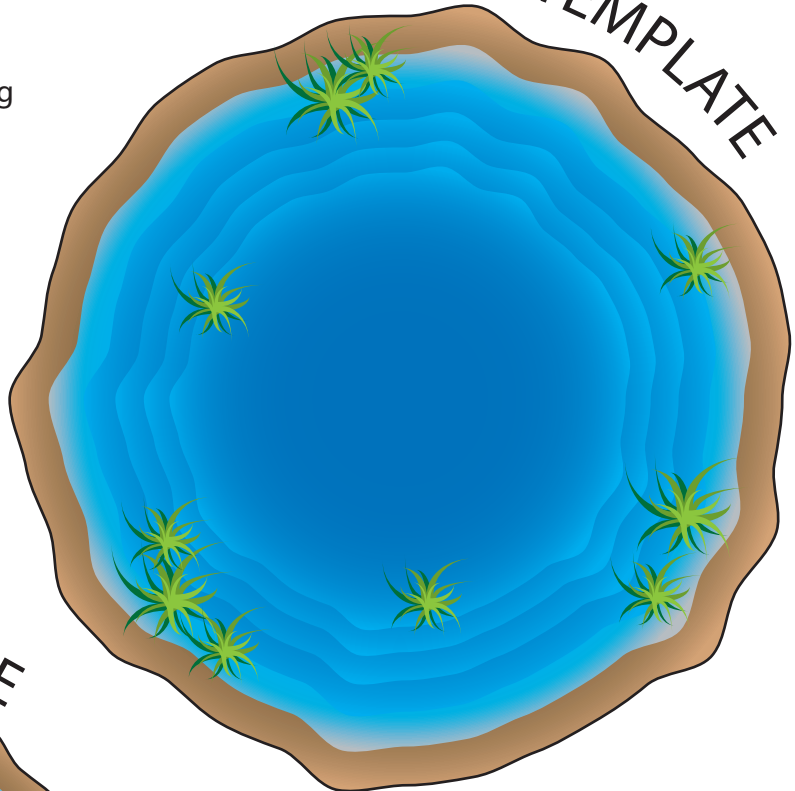

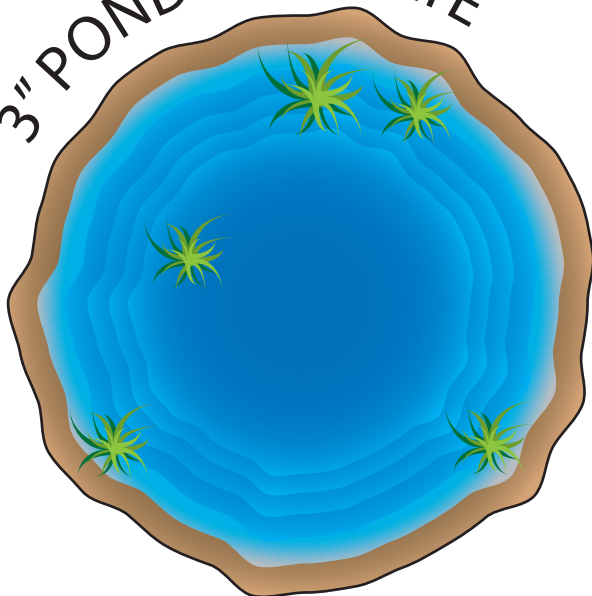

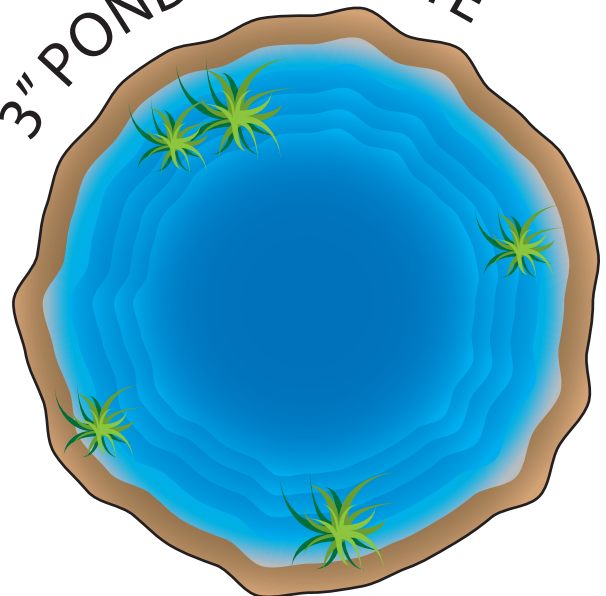
4" POND TEMPLATE



3" POND TEMPLATE

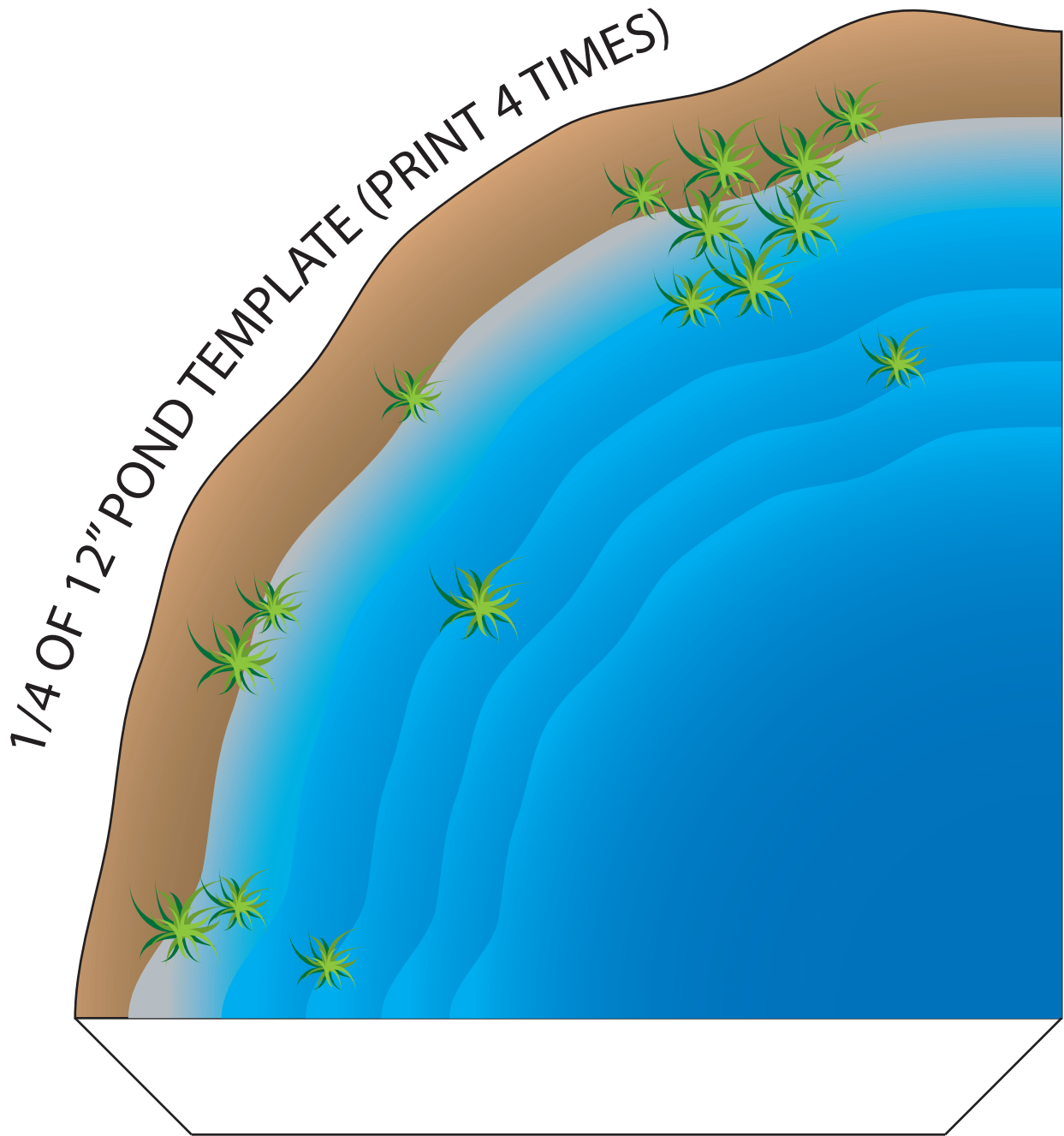

Glue the four copies of the above pond section together like the pieces of a pie to make a circle as in FIGURE A. Glue pond templates from page one under the large pond in overlapping sections to create irregular shaped lakes as in FIGURE B and FIGURE C.
