

# Four-fold Story Board

Scene #

This is a quick and copy-free method of storyboarding for students. Fold a piece of copy paper or graph paper into quarters and label the quarters with the words **See**, **Say**, **Need** and **Do**. In the top right corner, write the scene number to help keep the scenes in order. Use the descriptions below as an example

<b>See</b> Describe the scene location or images that will be on-screen.	<b>Say</b> Write the lines for each character or the voice-over you will record.
<p><i>This scene will be filmed at the playground swings. We will have a video of someone pushing a friend on the swing.</i></p>	<p><i>Person pushing: "A force is a push or a pull."</i></p> <p><i>Person on swing: "Force gives an object the energy to move."</i></p>
<b>Need</b> List the props, extras and equipment needed for this scene.	<b>Do</b> List each team member's responsibilities - who will play each role, who will film, who will manage props.
<p><i>Playground swings and video camera</i></p>	<p><i>Jacob: Camera person</i></p> <p><i>Julie: Person pushing</i></p> <p><i>John: Person on swing</i></p>
