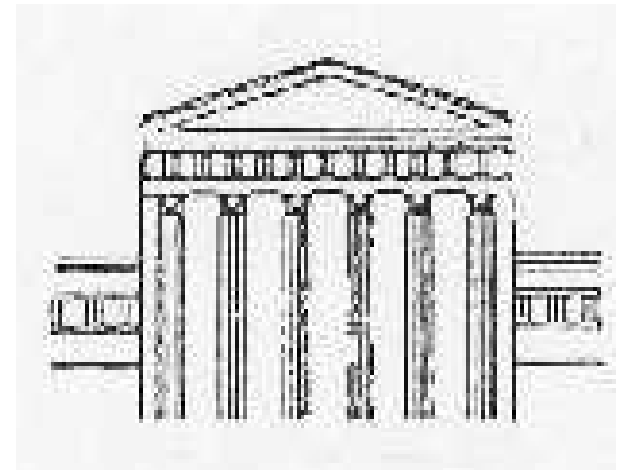

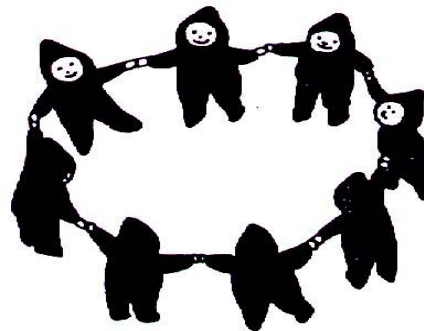
Curriculum

The focus of our curriculum is to meet the needs of the whole child. We work on such skills as respect for one's self and others, social development, and enhancing fine and gross motor skills. We encourage individual children's abilities in language, arts, mathematics, social studies and science. We teach these skills and abilities through the use of themes and units. We chose our activities, materials and books carefully. We strive to avoid sexual stereotyping, racial discrimination and violence in all activities.

Admissions

Children must be 2.9 years to 4.9 years to participate in the program. We recommend the children be toilet trained, although this is not a requirement. Proof of immunization and paperwork for your child's file must be submitted before beginning the program. Proof of a physical must follow within two weeks and renewed annually.
