

FRANKLIN COUNTY HOMEMAKERS EXHIBITOR
RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitors must be at least 18 years old and resident of Franklin County. Products must have been made within the last year. All entries (food, crafts, clothing and quilts) must be made by the persons who are made in on the entry blank. All entries should be covered with CLEAR plastic, and will not otherwise covered. Items are exhibited at your own risk DO NOT TOUCH EXHIBITS signs will be posted.
2. Entries will be accepted Wed, evening July 30, 2008 from 7PM to 8PM and Thursday morning July 31, 2008 from 9AM to Noon. Late entries will be refused. Judging starts promptly at 1PM
3. Entry forms must be filled out for each item entered. Entry forms are available on the FCFD web site. SELF STICK NAME AND ADDRESS LABELS ARE VERY HELPFUL. There are four categories you may enter – Food, Craft, Clothing and quilts. Each category is divided into individual classes. AN INDIVIDUAL MAY ENTER ONLY ONE ITEM PER CLASS, BUT MAY ENTER AS MANY CLASSES AS SHE/HE WISHES. ANY ITEM THAT FITS INTO A LISTED CLASS MAY NOT BE PUT INTO ANOTHER CLASS, BUT MAY NE DISPLAYED WITHOUT BEING JUDGED.
4. There are 3 premiums per class
 - 1st Blue ribbon \$5.00 premium
 - 2nd Red ribbon \$3.00 premium
 - 3rd Yellow ribbon \$2.00 premiumBest of show, each Category - \$25.00
5. ENTRIES MUST BELEFT ON DISPLAY UNTIL SUNDAY, AUGUST 3rd AND WILL BE RELEASED AFTER ALL THE RAFFLES HAVE BEEN DRAWN AT 6PM. ENTRANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PICKING UP THEIR ITEMS BEFORE 6:30 PM. We are not responsible for items not picked up. All premiums for ribbons will be given out when items are picked up – see a member of the committee.

FOOD CATEGORY

Include entire recipe, neatly printed or typed. Do not include name. Items must be on disposable plates and covered with CLEAR plastic wrap. All items must be from scratch (NO MIXES) except item #11

1. Yeast Bread and Rolls (8)
2. Quick Bread (loaf), Coffee Cake or Muffins(8)
3. Drop or Rolled Cookies (8)
4. Bar Cookies or Brownies (8)

5. Pie: Baked Fruit (1 or 2 Crust), baked Pumpkin, Baked Pecan. NO CREAM, CUSTARD, MEAT, CHEESE OR OTHER REFRIGERATED PIES.
6. Candy (8)
7. Doughnuts (8)
8. Cake (No Cream Cheese Frosting)
9. Maple item (Recipe using Maple Syrup or sugar)
10. Diabetic: Baked Goods
11. Baked goods using mixes as part of recipe.
